15	NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that any individual ordered to pay
16	fines or fees in a case in the district, metropolitan, magistrate, or municipal court
17	that are due between May 30, 2020, and June 30, 2020, shall be granted an
18	additional thirty (30) days from the original due date to pay said fines and fees; and
19	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order does not enlarge the additional

- time already granted by this Court in Order No. 20-8500-005 to pay certain fines
- and fees assessed in district, metropolitan, magistrate, and municipal court cases.
